CONSIDER APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION 24-05: CONSIDERATION OF **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE AND SALE OF NOT MORE THAN** AGGREGATE \$19.000.000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF TAX-EXEMPT **TELECOMMUNICATIONS REVENUE BONDS (THE "BONDS"); FIXING THE** MAXIMUM AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE BONDS, THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF YEARS OVER WHICH THE BONDS MAY MATURE, THE MAXIMUM INTEREST RATE WHICH THE BONDS MAY BEAR. AND THE MAXIMUM DISCOUNT FROM PAR AT WHICH THE BONDS MAY BE SOLD; DELEGATING TO CERTAIN OFFICERS OF THE UTAH INFRASTRUCTURE AGENCY THE AUTHORITY TO APPROVE THE FINAL TERMS **PROVISIONS OF THE BONDS WITHIN THE PARAMETERS SET FORTH IN THE RESOLUTION: SETTING THE DATE OF A PUBLIC HEARING RELATED TO THE BONDS; PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF A NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING** AND BONDS TO BE ISSUED; PROVIDING FOR THE RUNNING OF A CONTEST AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING PERIOD: THE EXECUTION OF SUPPLEMENTAL INDENTURE, A BOND PURCHASE CONTRACT, AND OTHER **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED IN CONNECTION THEREWITH; AUTHORIZING AND** THE **DISTRIBUTION** PRELIMINARY **OFFICIAL** APPROVING OF Α STATEMENT, AND AN OFFICIAL STATEMENT; AUTHORIZING THE TAKING OF ALL OTHER ACTIONS NECESSARY TO THE CONSUMMATION OF THE TRANSACTIONS CONTEMPLATED BY THE RESOLUTION; AND RELATED MATTERS.

 - This UIA General Revenue Bond is a smaller amount than previous ones and is for the purpose of keeping up with installations and incremental growth
 - Bond Parameters were reviewed
 - A public hearing is required and will be set for September 9, 2024
 - Projected revenue growth attributed to this bond is about \$6 million

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ACTION: Brenda Moore (Murray City) MOVED to approve Resolution 24-05 Authorizing the Issuance and Sale of not more than \$19,000,000 Aggregate Principal Amount of Tax-Exempt Telecommunications Revenue Bonds and Related Matters; and setting a time and date for the Public Hearing on September 9, 2024. Zach Bloxham (Layton City) SECONDED the motion. A roll call vote was taken - vote was unanimous.
